Every adult in the Church has to help keep children safe by following the policy of the National Board for Safeguarding Children in the Catholic Church in Ireland

THE POLICY SAYS THAT ADULTS SHOULD...

- Treat children with respect at all times
- Never shout at children
- Never hurt children
- Always keep children safe from adults who could hurt or abuse them
- Make sure children treat each other with respect

WHAT IS ABUSE?

Abuse can be... Physical, Emotional, Sexual, Neglect or Bullying

WHAT SHOULD I DO IF SOMEONE HURTS ME?

If someone hurts you or makes you feel uncomfortable or upset you should always...

- Tell them to stop - Say No!
- Get away from them
- Tell an adult you trust

It is never your fault if someone hurts you and you should never keep secrets about it!
